ELIGIBILITY FOR
NOMINATION AS A
CATHOLIC SCHOOL
BOARD TRUSTEE

A person is eligible to vote in a school board trustee election if they:

- are at least 18 years of age;
- are a Canadian citizen; and
- reside in Alberta and their place of residence is located in the school board boundaries on election day.

A person can be nominated as a school board trustee in any election if they:

- are eligible to vote in this election;
- have been a resident of the local jurisdiction and the ward for the six consecutive months immediately preceding nomination day,
- and are not otherwise ineligible.

FAITH-BASED ELIGIBILITY

Where a separate school district is established, an individual residing in the boundaries of the established area is considered a separate elector if they declare they are of the same faith (either Protestant or Roman Catholic) as those who established the separate school district.
