## EICS Board Meeting Highlights April 21, 2021

## **Government of Alberta Draft K-6 Curriculum**

After a thorough review process that involved teaching staff in each of the seven subject areas, and after surveying parents and stakeholders, the Board voted unanimously to not pilot Alberta's draft K-6 curriculum. EICS will continue to work with administration, teachers and parents to review and provide feedback on the draft curriculum to the Ministry of Education. Trustees and administration thanked parents and staff for reaching out via phone and email with their feedback.

## **New Business**

## 2021-2022 Division Fees

The Board approved the 2021-2022 Division School Fees as presented. All fees remain the same with the exception of:

- a new fee for out of province students, who are not resident students of Alberta under the Education Act, and are not eligible for public finding according to the funding manual.
- an increase in fees for Chesterton Academy Online students, adjusted to reflect the base instruction grant as per the funding manual.
- an increase in school rental fees of 1.4% over 2020-2021 school rental fees.

## City of Fort Saskatchewan Task Force

Board of Trustees received correspondence from the City of Fort Saskatchewan, requesting representatives from Elk Island Catholic Schools for their task force on surplus school sites. The Board moved to have 2 trustees represent EICS at any upcoming meetings.
